Upgrade your airport experience with NEXUS

At Edmonton International Airport (EIA), NEXUS now gives you access to a new dedicated fast-track security lane.

Because NEXUS cardholders have been pre-cleared, they can access a special pre-board security screening line at EIA.

You may know NEXUS as the card that gets you across the border quicker, but now it provides you with even more convenience.

No waiting in security lineups!

Show your NEXUS card at EIA's central security screening before you get in line and you will be sent straight to the fast lane!

Whether you're travelling to a Canadian, US or any other international destination, NEXUS – makes your airport experience even easier.

What is NEXUS?

NEXUS is a joint Canada-United States program designed to expedite the border crossing procedures for pre-approved trusted travellers. Program members can avoid lines at border entry points by using self-serve kiosks at select airports and dedicated lanes at select highway ports of entry.

The Canadian Air Transport Security Authority (CATSA) is responsible for passenger security screening, and are partnering with the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) and Transport Canada to extend the NEXUS benefits to include designated security screening lines at certain Canadian Airports, including EIA. These 'Trusted Traveller' CATSA Security Lines are now available to NEXUS cardholders to help move them through screening more quickly.



NEW at NEXUS

Canadians who have a NEXUS card will be able to jump the queue at US airports participating in the TSA preapproved program, when taking domestic flights within the United States. 27 airports participate presently, as the program continues to grow.



'Trusted Traveller' CATSA Security Line at EIA Central Hall

How does the designated security line help you?

Just show your NEXUS card and boarding pass to access the specially marked security line at the airport security checkpoint for flights bound for other Canadian and international destinations (excluding the US). As a NEXUS member you do not need first class airline tickets or frequent flyer status to use the security line.

Where is the Trusted Traveller CATSA Security Line?

The Trusted Traveller CATSA Security Line at EIA is located at Central Hall pre-board security screening. This screening area processes passengers for both Canadian and International destinations. The designated line is located on the left side as you approach security. Just look for the NEXUS sign at the security area!

Global Entry at EIA

NEXUS members are also eligible to use Global Entry kiosks now at EIA and other Canadian and US Airports.

Global Entry is a US program designed for expedited clearance to the United States and when arriving into some US airports from International flights.

Follow the easy to use on-screen instructions at the newly installed kiosks located at the US preclearance entrance at EIA.
